**FUN FACTS**

The emblem of Po Leung Kuk was established in 1951. **Red**, **white**, **yellow** and **blue** are used, in which white symbolises purity of hearts and red symbolises passion.

The shield shape symbolises protection and safety, which echo with our vision of “Protection of children and women.”

The circle at the centre signifies an endless effort of charity, whereas the 36 lines around it are beams of light, symbolising the glory of our charitable work.
