- 3. With effect from 1 July 2012, bookings could be made within **9 months** on a first-come first-served basis. Three days in advanced booking or walk-in camping is welcome if vacancies are still available. Organisations such as schools, welfare organisations, sports organisations, youth groups and government departments under Education Bureau, Social Welfare Department, Leisure and Cultural Services Department, Home Affairs Bureau and Civil Service Bureau may have their bookings made within **12 months** on a first-come first-served basis.
